#### **HEAD COACH – Gregg Emde**

A graduate of Parkway West, Emde was the starting 2-meter for the undefeated State Championship Team. His Junior year, the team was second in the state and his Sophomore year, they were third. He was selected All-State his senior year and also played on the Junior Olympic bronze medal team in the summer prior to his senior year. He also swam for two State Championship swim teams at West. Playing polo in college at Denison University and Ohio University, Emde was selected captain and helped coach the inaugural Ohio University team.

Coach Emde refereed high school polo prior to becoming Marquette High School's Head Coach in 2002. His teams have been to the Final Four twice and the Elite Eight every year but one. The JV program is regularly in the running for the best team in the Conference. He has been selected twice as the Conference Coach of the Year (2007 & 2008) and is one of two Level 3 coaches, through USA Water Polo, in the St. Louis Area. He has been trained at the Olympic Training Center and is one of the coaches for the Midwest Zone Boys' Youth Team, traveling to Zone Championships and other tournaments throughout the country.

Emde has also taken over the Head Swim Coach positions at Marquette in 2007 and has enjoyed an undefeated season and Conference Championship in the boys and a Conference Runner-Up in the Girls.

Coach Emde started Mad Dog Water Polo in 1999 as part of a summer development program. The program that started with 8 players now is one of the largest and most recognized programs from St. Louis.
